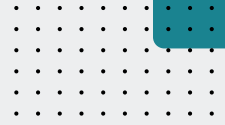

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UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM

ACCOUNTING



- Undergraduate Program in Accounting strives to seek international recognition, integrating entrepreneurial spirit as well as the awareness of spirituality, humanity, and the environment.
- It is accredited by the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA), United Kingdom and ICAEW (Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales).
- It regularly conducts cooperation with practitioners and entrepreneurs, some of them are from PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC), Deloitte, Ernst and Young (EY), Tax Directorate, and Bank Indonesia.

MANAGEMENT



IUP Management is a prestigious and well-regarded study program. The curriculum is created with input from both internal and external stakeholders in mind. It is then reviewed by professionals in the domains of management science, business, associations, and user needs. IUP Management offers students the chance to study the most recent management theories and develop understanding of business strategies used in the real world, helping you to realize your career goals in the management industry.

ECONOMICS, FINANCES, AND BANKING



- The curriculum is designed to produce graduates who become data analysts, practitioners, and consultants in the fields of economics, finance, banking, and capital markets
- It includes various course specializations in the areas of banking specialization, capital markets specialization, and finance
- Economics Financial and Banking study program also collaborates with financial and banking institutions to increase students' soft skills in the practical field

MASTER PROGRAM

ACCOUNTING



- The study program's curriculum, which consists of 54 credit points, aims to develop students' skills in solving managerial problems in the Accounting field as well as developing knowledge through research with a multi-paradigm perspective.
- Master program in Accounting students are also equipped with the latest study materials to support their professional skills in the Accounting field by providing them with several concentrations, namely Financial Accounting, Accounting Information Systems, Public Sector Accounting, Sharia Financial Accounting, Tax Accounting, and Management Accounting.

MANAGEMENT



- The study program emphasizes a creative and innovative learning process to produce ethical, creative, and innovative managers, entrepreneurs, intrapreneurs, management consultants, and senior researchers.
- This study program offers 5 concentrations namely, Marketing Management, Financial Management, Human Resource Management, Strategic Management, and Operational Management. The study program load is a total of 54 credit points.

ECONOMICS



- Designed as an educational institution based on Economics, this study program is committed to producing graduates who are competent as policymakers, researchers, and lecturers. The study program has 4 concentrations, namely Development Economics, Finance and Banking, Sharia Economics as well as Development Planning and Regional Finance. The total credits of the study program are 54 credit points.
- The study program also offers a Double Degree Program with overseas partner universities, namely Rikkyo University, International University of Japan, National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies, and Macquarie University.

DOCTORAL PROGRAM

ACCOUNTING



- The study program provides students with a comprehensive understanding of accounting research methodology from various paradigms (multi-paradigm), namely the paradigms of positivism, interpretivism, criticism, and postmodernism with various disciplines such as Psychology, Sociology, Agriculture, and others.
- The curriculum for this study program has a study load of 56 credit points with 7 concentrations namely Management Accounting, Sharia Accounting, Public Sector Accounting, Financial Accounting, Sustainability Accounting, Auditing, and Accounting Information System.

MANAGEMENT



- This study program is the right place for developing knowledge for future leaders. The curriculum is structured with a theoretical and practical approach that is able to improve graduate competence.
- The curriculum for this study program has a load of 52 credit points. Students are also offered 5 concentrations, such as Financial Management, Strategic Management, Marketing Management, Human Resources Management, and Operations Management.

ECONOMICS



This study program is committed to producing graduates who have competence as policy makers, researchers, and lecturers. The Doctoral Program in Economics has a study load of 46 credit points. The students are also able to choose their preferred concentrations, namely Development Economics, Development Planning and Regional Finance, and Islamic Economics.

EXCHANGE PROGRAM

There will be no tuition fees and they will study in class with other foreign and local students in International Class. Students will study for one semester at FEB UB and take a maximum of 24 credits. Students will have an excellent opportunity to expand their knowledge.





INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL

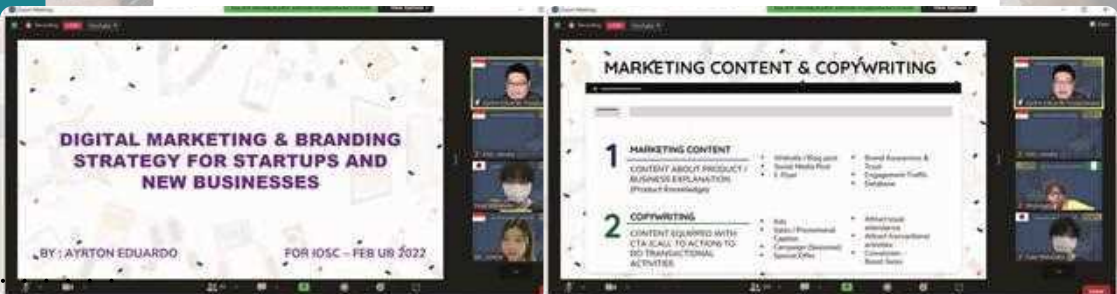

VIRTUAL ONLINE CLASS

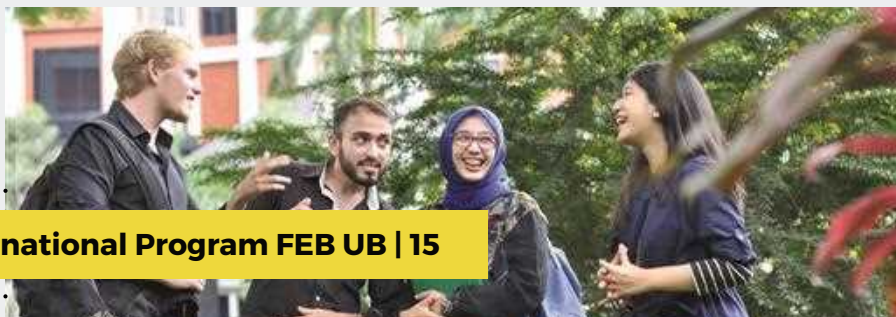

HOW TO APPLY IUP



All programs have the same requirement process and prospective students must meet these requirements:

1. Language requirement:

All courses will be delivered in English. If English is not the first language, students are required to fulfill minimum language requirements with TOEFL ITP > 525 or IELTS > 5.5

2. Required Application Documents:

HOW TO APPLY POSTGRADUATE PROGRAM

MASTER PROGRAM



Prospective applicants are graduates of the bachelor program demonstrating good academic competence proven by high academic merit and having a minimum GPA of 3.00 (a 4.00 scale GPA).

Prospective applicants should have:

- TOEFL ITP \geq 500 atau IELTS 5.5.

Prospective applicants of the Master Program by Research should include proof of publication at least 1 (one) international publication.

DOCTORAL PROGRAM



Prospective applicants are graduates of the master program demonstrating good academic competence proven by high academic merit and having a minimum GPA of 3.00 (a 4.00 scale GPA).

Prospective applicants should have:

- TOEFL ITP \geq 525 or IELTS 6.

Prospective applicants of the Doctoral Program by Research should include proof of publication at least 2 (two) international publications.
